MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 30th,  
1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 30th day of December, A.D. 1932,  
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and  
for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with  
the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Coms. Ward No. 1,
C. A. Burke,	Coms. Ward No. 2,
M. M. Jones,	Coms. Ward No. 3,
W. A. Abney,	Coms. Ward No. 4, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary, and
	Acting City Manager.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Eulen Berry, representing W.P. Berry, appeared before the City  
Commission and protested against the payment of water bills for the  
months ending November 20th and December 20th, stating that the cause  
of the high bills was because of a leaking comode and possibly a "bad  
order meter". After hearing the protest, it was ordered by the City  
Commission that settlement be made on a basis of one-half of the amount  
shown by the meter.

Mr. C. L. DuPuy, representing the Chamber of Commerce, appeared  
before the City Commission, and desired to know if the City would re-  
new the air port lease with J.E. Berry for another year, at a price of  
\$100.00 per annum. After hearing the argument favoring the renewal of  
said lease, it was moved by C.A. Burke and seconded by M.M. Jones that  
this City Commission go on record as favoring the putting in the 1933-  
34 budget the sum of \$100.00 to provide for one-half of the annual  
rental on the air port, the other one-half to be paid by the Chamber  
of Commerce. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. C. L. DuPuy recommended the appointment of Eulen Berry as Air  
Port Manager for the ensuing year, without pay. C. A. Burke made a mo-  
tion which was seconded by M. M. Jones, that the said Eulen be appointed  
to the position of Air Port Manager for the ensuing year, without pay.  
The Motion carried.
