Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Lufkin Texas

That it shall be unlawful for any locomotive
Engineer, fireman, brakeman, or any other
Railway or Railroad Employee or Locomotive or
Motor driver or operator to propel, drive
or operate any engine, Motor car or
train through the corporate limits of
the City of Lufkin at a rate of speed
greater or exceeding Eight miles per
hour, any person or persons
violating the provisions of
this ordinance shall be deemed
guilty of a misdemeanor
and upon conviction thereof
shall be fined in any sum
not less than \$25.00 nor more
than \$100.00 This ordinance shall take effect and be
enforced from and after its adoption & publication
adopted this 8th day of January 1907 —
