

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JULY 21,
1953 at 7:30 P.M.

On This the 21st day of July, A.D., 1953, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin convened in regular session at the regular meeting place in said City with the following members thereof present:

1. The minutes of special mmetting held July 14, 1953, at 7:30 P.M. were read and approved.

2. Mr. Redditt and Mr. Henderson and residents of the Harmony Hill Community asked the Commission for permission to run an additional 2" waterline from Two Point area on Farm Road off of East Denman Ave., to connect with their present 2" line connected to main on Highway 59 or Houston Highway. The Commission agreed to this extension and said users to pay for material to extend present 6 inch line on Fram Road to City Limits and cost of said 6" line to be amortized over a period of five years. The motion was by Gipson, seconded by Nerren. All voting "Aye."

3. The Commission granted permission to residents living outside City Limits on Huntington Highway to extend a 2" line from present 6" line at the City Limits on said Highway to serve approximately 13 families.

4. Granted premision to Mr. Ellison to extend a 2" line from 6" line adjacent to U. S. Forest Service on Highway 69.

5. Accepted proposal presented by Mr. Tom Maroney for the use of fogging machine twice yearly. This machine to be owned by an agency, and the city would have free use of same, but would purchase insecticide when machine was used.

6. The Commission agreed to contact all civic organizations of the City for donations to be applied on the construction of Fire Station on Ellis Ave.

7. Instructed City Attorney to prepare Zone Change for location of new fire station on Ellis Ave.

8. Approved payment of all bills as presented by City Manager for the Month of June, 1953.

9. The Commission agreed to apply to the State Water Conservation Board for water rights from the Angelina & Neches Rivers.

10. The Commission approved Budget for the year of April 1, 1953 - March 31, 1954, as presented by the City Manager.

11. The Commission instructed City Manager to advertise for bids on City owned houses located on north First Street and South Timberland Drive.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
