MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE

Be it remembered that on this the 8th day of April, A.D. 1938, there was held a call meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The purpose of the meetings was stated to be to pass an ordinance declaring the result of the regular General City Election; to install newly election officers and do and perform any other matter that might properly come before the meeting:

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONVAISSING THE RETURNS AND DELCAR-  
IN THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR T  
THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN  
APRIL A. D. 1938, SAME BEING THE 5th DAY OF APRIL  
A.D. 1938, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COM-  
MISSIONER FROM WARD NO. TWO AND A CITY COMMISSION  
ER FROM WARD NO FOUR."

was introduced for passage and approval. The Ordinance was read to the City Commission, and J. B. Perry made a motion that said ordinance be passed and approved. The motion was seconded by J. E. Jay. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recored vote on the motion. "Ayes"- W.M.Glenn, W.D. Windston, Jr, Lewis Hicks, J.B.Perry and J.E.Jay. "NOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.

The question of wheter the City would pay the expenses of Fire Marshal W.L. Jones and Fire Chief Harry Kerr to attend the State Firemen's Conven-  
tion to be held at Amarillo in June. After discussing the matter it was moved  
by Lewis Hicks and seconed by J.B.Perry that the City will pay such expenses.  
The Motion carried unanimously.
