constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of the meetings held during November were read and approved.

2. Mr. V. G. Koch, District Highway Engineer-Mr. Mattox from the State Highway Department at Austin, and Mr. Mitchell, Resident Highway Engineer were present and presented suggestions with reference to location of Highway 59 Loop through the City.

3. This suggested change from the location which had already been approved, was explained by Mr. Mattox and was discussed at length after which motion was made by D. M. Thrash, second by J. A. Abney, and carried that the State Highway Department be requested to follow the location adopted by the City Commission, December 9, 1944 and September 26, 1944.

4. November bills amounting to \$2,825.19 were presented for approval and on motion of J. A. Abney, second by B. F. Milligan were approved and ordered paid.

No other business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
