Mayor Glenn announced the purpose of the meeting was for consideration of the purchase of some City Bonds that were offered on the market, the bonds being \$6,000.00 of Series 1936-A 5% bonds maturing in 1959 and 1960.

After discussing the matter motion was made by B.F.Milligan, second by Arthur Temple, Jr. and carried by all voting yea., authorizing purchase of these bonds, at a saving of 2-3/4 % or better.

Nothing further was offered for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
