

Luptkin, Texas, August 1st, 1893

Regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Luptkin, Texas, J.R. McMaster, Mayor, in the Chair. Aldermen Butler, Vinson, Medford, McPherson and Ballew present. Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Report of Marshal Ellis for month of July, 1893 examined and approved. Reported filed with Town Treasurer. Account of A. J. Ellis against the Town of Luptkin for salary and jail expenses for July, 1893 for \$150 allowed. J.R. McMaster settled with Town of Luptkin by paying Treasurer \$650 and taking his receipt therefor.

Total ad valorem and poll collections for July, 1893: \$94.07 - Occupation taxes collected, July, 1893, \$2125.

Resignation of J.R. McMaster as Mayor of the Town of Luptkin presented to the Board of Aldermen and by them accepted.

On motion B.L. McPherson was elected Mayor of the Town of Luptkin, Texas, vice J.R. McMaster, resigned.

On motion, F.B. Fowler was elected Secretary of the Board of Aldermen, vice B.L. McPherson, elected Mayor.

B.L. McPherson was then administered the oath of office according to law, and took the Chair.

Secretary directed to issue check to J.R. McMaster, \$1000, for salary for July, 1893.

Upon motion, Council adjourned to meet Aug. 7, 1893.
