the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor S. R. Parker, Jr.
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of October 21, 1958, were read and approved.
3. The amendment to the Water and Sewer Ordinance granting churches inside the City limits summer water rates, and sewer rates as follows,

Churches	Inside City	Outside City
Commode (per month)	\$1.00	\$2.00
Each additional commode (per month)	.25	.50,


was passed on second and final reading.

4. The Commission postponed the charge off of certain personal taxes, that is, automobile taxes, because the owners thereof lived outside the City of Lufkin, until the City Manager has time to check such tax list as furnished by the City Tax Collector.
5. The second amendment to the Vumore Ordinance No. 970, as heretofore requested by R. W. Wortham and John S. Redditt, was passed on second and final reading.
6. The amendment to the Zoning Ordinance changing the zoning designation from "A" District to "F" District on the West seventy-five (75) feet of Lot No. Ten (10), in Block No. One (1), of the West Eastwood Addition to the City of Lufkin, as requested by the owner, C. E. Phillips, was passed on second and final reading.
7. The amendment to the Zoning Ordinance changing the zoning designation from "A" District to "F" District on Lots Nos. Two (2) through Eleven (11),

Block No. Two (2), of the Noble Addition to the City of Lufkin, and Lots Nos. One (1) through Twelve (12), Block No. Four (4), of the Bynum Addition, to the City of Lufkin, as requested by the owners thereof, Arthur Temple, Jr., H. W. Spencer and Betty Coward, was passed on second and final reading.

8. The amendment to the Zoning Ordinance as requested by Alex W. Conn, the owner, to change the zoning designation from "A" District to "F" District on Lot No. One (1), in Block No. Forty-six (46), of the Denman Addition to the City of Lufkin, was passed on first reading.

9. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
