2. Inquiry as to whether the City would sell 26 acres of land South of the City was reported. No official action was taken but expressions indicated the land was not for sale at present.
3. Mr. C.B.Ragland presented a plan for Honor Roll the V. F. W. is sponsoring, for Angelina County Een and Women in the Armed service of the United Nations and solicited a contribution from the City to help pay the expense.
The matter of passing on the amount of the contribution was deferred to a meeting with full attendance of the Commission.
5. Proposition to use Central Ward School grounds during the Summer vacation period for papervised play ground was discussed and Mr. Lewis was requested to work out a plan with Superintende Wells and make recommendation to the Commission.
6. On motion of B.F.Milligan, second by Jas. A.Abney and carried by all members voting yea, the offer of \$1,500.00 for the old City Repair shop building was accepted and the Mayor and City Secretary authorized make the sale and execute bill of sale for the building.
7. Letter from J.L. Spotten, making application for Audit for the City for the two years beginning April 1st 1944 was read and discussed but no action was taken on it.
