On this the 6 day of June, A.D. 1944
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in
Regular session, in the regular meeting place in said

being present, and the following absent: None
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of our meetings held during the month of May were read and regularly approved.
2. The matter of the City entering into Contract with the State Highway Dept., where the State Dept. would maintain Highway 69 through the City was discussed. Afterwards motion was made by J. A. Abney, second by Arthur Temple, Jr. and carried by all members voting yes, that the contract in Regular Form as proposed by the Highway Dept. be approved and executed and then forward to the Highway Dept. for their execution.
3. An Ordinance ~~setting~~ the Tax Rate for the City for the year 1944, at \$1.75. Half of which is to be put in General Fund and half in Int. and SKG. Fund, was introduced by ~~B.B.B.~~ Milligan, second by J. A. Abney, and passed on first reading by the members voting yes.
4. The Ordinance was introduced for passage on second reading by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by J. A. Abney, and passed on by the members voting yes.
5. Motion was made by J. A. Abney, second by B. F. Milligan authorizing purchase of \$10,000 of Series "G" War Bonds from the General Fund. This was carried by unanimous vote.

No futher business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
