

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,  
HELD FEBRUARY 1st, 1927.

Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of February, A. D. 1927,  
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of  
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City;  
Present and presiding the following officers of the City, to-wit: J.W.  
Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker,  
Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3  
E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager,  
W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the fol-  
lowing proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and car-  
ried were approved as read.

W. D. Winston, representative of the Lufkin Foundary and Machine  
Company, appeared and asked permission to construct or move switch on  
H. E. & W. T. Ry. at or near S. Raguet Street crossing a little fur-  
ther South in order that such switch may cross entirely over the said  
South Raguet Street Crossing on said railroad. After hearing Mr. Win-  
ston present his reasons for making such move, it was moved by Joe C.  
Denman and seconded by A. M. Walker, that the Lufkin Foundary and Ma-  
chine Company be allowed to move the switche as asked for. The motion  
Carried unanimously.

The Lufkin Foundary & Machine Company appeared by representative  
and asked permission to close that certain alley in block No. 86 of  
the City of Lufkin, Texas. On motion made by E.W. Leach and seconded  
by Joe C. Denman it was ordered that an ordinance be prepared author-  
izing the closing of said alley. The motion carried unanimously.

The question of the City taking membership in the League of Texas  
Municipalities was taken under consideration, after which on motion  
made by A. M. Walker and seconded by Joe C. Denman, it was unanimous-  
ly carried that the city take membership as aforesaid.

The question of the City paying for a six inch sewer line extend-  
ing from the manhole in South Raguet and Menefee street intersection  
to and in front of Sam H. Kerr's proerty, extending along said South

Raguet Street. After discussion of the question it was moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman that payment of said sewer line be and the said is hereby refused. The motion carried unanimously.

Accounts and bills due by the city to various parties, firms or corporations were presented for payment and appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed as appears in the minutes of accounts allowed.
