1955, AT 7:30 A.M.

the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened
in regular session, in the regular meeting place in

being present, and the following absent: Granville Wright, Com-
missioner Ward #1, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The Meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The Minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 18, 1955, were read and approved.
3. Bob Day appeared before the Commission and gave an analysis of the water needs of the City of Lufkin. After discussing the water needs of the City, it was agreed that the City Manager might check on the City's outstanding indebtedness and that the water situation would be discussed further when additional information was had.
4. Jim Thomas, a tie cutter, submitted to the Commission a proposal to buy the hardwood tie timber on the Jones Lake and City Lake property.

5. The City Manager was authorized to secure prices for the painting of the Water Tower on Bynum Street.

6. A Resolution was passed authorizing the City Attorney to institute condemnation proceedings against John Kennedy for right-of-way in the widening and extension of Lufkin Avenue.

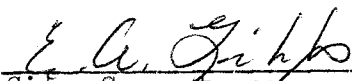
