MINUTES OF FIGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD OCTOBER 6th, 1936.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of October, A.D. 1936, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of meetings held during the month of September, 1936, were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

The City Manager was ordered and directed to request the T & N.O. Railroad Company to install a standard street light at their crossing on Davis Street, which is at north side of their round house property.

The City Manager was instructed to take up again with the Texas Power & Light Company the matter of getting a refund of \$649.00 which amount was spent by the City in construction of power line to the City Disposal plant. This move being made on account of the fact that said Texas Power & Light Company had recently made a rural electrification project in that section of the county and had used the line which was partly paid for by the city as a part of said rural project.

Other matters relating to city affairs was discussed but no record action taken regarding any of them.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
