A Committee of ladies representing the Girl Scouts were present and asked permission to use the basement of the Community Center Building for a regular meeting place for the Girl Scouts. They were granted this reguest. Members of this Committee were: Mrs. Geo. Henderson, Mrs. Jean Shotwell, Mrs. W. W. Trout, Mrs. E. W. Leach and Mrs. Jack Talkington.

Gordon Odum and Leo Bishop were present and asked permission to transfer three Taxi Cab permits previously granted them to another party. It was pointed out by the City Attorney that these permits were not transferable.

Mrs. Mable Jones appeared before the Commission and requested that the Fire Limits be so changed that she could be granted a permit to construct a wood frame building on lot 6, Block 26 of the original town of Lufkin. She was told that an investigation would be made in order to determine the feasibility of such a change and to find out if

it would affect the fire insurance rate.

This Hill Baggett of the Junior Chamber of Commerce was a visitor of the meeting. He was told by the Mayor that the Commission appreciated the Junior Chamber and that they wanted to help them and work with them in any worthwhile movement for the good of the Community, but that he felt that there should be a clear understanding between the two bodies perore any definite action or publicity be given to any project. Lr. Baggett stated that in his opinion, that this was the feeling of the Junior Chamber Lembership as a whole.
