The question about hamburger wagons etc. dispensing hamburgers, iee cream, candies etc. to the public in general and especially to the school children was discussed as to whether or not the city had authority to pass an ordinance and enforce same prohibiting the operation of same. It was decided that the city could not enforce an ordinance prohibiting the operation of such, but that they could require all parties handling food products as such and in such manner to secure a health certificate from a reputable physician, and it was ordered that the city Health Officer enforce such order.

The question of paving South Cotton Street was discussed and it was decided that same could not be paved until funds were available for that purpose.
