

1. Also present were Mr. J. B. Nabers, State Hiway District Engineer, V. G. Koch, Assistant Engineer and Mr. Bossey from the State Hiway Department office at Austin.
2. The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting ~~was to~~ to discuss with the Hiway Department representatives the matter of providing additional Highway passage through the City to relieve the congested condition of traffic on North and South First Street.
3. After thorough discussion of the matter from all angles presented it was definitely agreed, without formal action, by the commission to abandon the route for the highway ~~as formerly proposed which was known as the North First Street and Chesnut street route as impractical as well as too expensive and that the City Manager work with the State Hiway department in an effort to find the most logical route and submit to the City Commission.~~
4. Request was also made of Mr. Nabers that ~~in as much as~~ the through hiway would have to be located East of Chesnut street, he recommend that the Hiway department include with the proposed improvement the opening up ~~of~~ of Third street to connect with North First street and with the new thoroughfare on the South, and this Mr. Nabers agreed to do.
5. Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
