- The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting was first to consider an application for change of Zone District from "A" to "M" on a strip of land Six Hundred feet wide lying immediately South of theirresectoffeer Planta the horkering undry & Machine Company, West of the T&NO Railroad and bordering on Harrell Street and extending to the present Southwest property line of the Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company.
- 2. Also for consideration was application for change of Zone District from "D" to "G" on Lots Four, Five and Six in Block Eighty Four of the Original Townsite.
- 3. In a written report to the City Commission, the City Zoning Commission recommended that both the above changes be made as requested in applications.
- 4 The matter of amending the City ordinance which required notice of public hearing on application for change of Zone District on property be published Fifteen days prior to the date set for hearing had been discussed at previous meetings and was brought up again and on motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by Jas. A. Abney, all members voting yea an amendment to this ordinance changing the time from Fifteen to Five days was passed on First Reading.

Motion was made by B.F.Milligan, second by Arthur Temple, Jr., that this amendment be passed on second and final reading was passed by all members voting yea.

5 Motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by Jas. A. Abney and passed by all members voting yea, that Mossday May 23rd at 10:00 AM be set as date for Public hearing on both of above applications for change of Zone District and that notice be published as required.

Question of making appropriation to the Local Veterans of Foreign Wars to help on cost of erecting an Honor Roll for Members of U. S. Armed forces from Angelina County was presented and on motion of D. M. Thrash, second by B. F. Milligan carried by all members voting yea, contribution of \$200.00 to this cause was authorized.

Planning for a Municipal Swimming Pool was discussed and motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by Jas. A. Abney and carried by all members voting yea, that a committee be appointed to investigate the possibilities for a swimming Pool, location, plan etc. and report to the Commission.

The Mayor appointed on this committee, Arthur Temple, Jr., D. M. Thrash and B. F. Milligan.

Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
