

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION HELD ON THE 21st day of October,
1921.

On this the 21st day of October, A. D. 1921, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in called session, with the following members present, to-wit: E. E. Woods, Mayor Protem, presiding, S. R. Parker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and Temporary City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

A representative of the American La France Fire Engine Company was present and went into details concerning their products in the way of Fire fighting Aparatms, and made several propositions to the City Commission as to prices and terms if they were in the market for a new Fire Engine. After consideration of the propsoition it was decided not to make purchase at this time.

Bids having been called for, for the construction of a sewer line from the intersection of Polk Avenue with Chesnut street, thence through said Chesnut Street in a northerly direction, and across property of E.E. Woods and J. W. Lawless to intersect North First Street in Front of the property of the said J. W. Lawless; thence north with North First street a distance of approximatley one thousand feet. The bids were opened and discussed by the City Commission, and it was ordered that each of same be rejected, and that the City Manager be and is hereby directed to proceed with the construction of said sewer with day labor.
